


- Approximately 80% of crime in New Zealand occurs under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- New Zealanders as a population have some of the higher drug-use rates in the developed world
- One in six (16.6%)
 New Zealanders aged
 16-64 years had used
 drugs recreationally in
 the past year.*
- 24.8% (of 16-17 year olds) report using cannabis in the last year.
- Highly dangerous drug use in young people includes volatile substance abuse (or huffing), responsible for the death of 25 people aged under 17 in the last ten years.
- New 'legal highs'
